5. All contestants must attend a pre-pageant meeting at the Wellwood. This meeting will take place at 6:00 pm. The pageant will take place at 7:00 pm
6. No parents are allowed in the backstage area.
7. An entry fee of \$25.00 is required to participate.
8. An entry fee of an additional \$10.00, only if you also want to compete in the Talent competition.
9. The winners must also dress appropriately for all events.

Pageant Information

Riverfest Queens serve as festival ambassadors. They should be well spoken, confident and poised. They will serve as guides and hostesses for the entire event, assisting with contests, presentations and events throughout the weekend. They should also be available for Riverfest fundraisers, and publicity events throughout the year.

Areas of Competition

All Contestants will compete in the following areas:

Questions will be asked by host from fact sheet provided by contestant and from random questions selected from bowl. Contestants will model a fancy dress such as party or homecoming wear for poise and grace. We are not judging the dress, just how well the contestant presents herself.

All Miss Riverfest contestants will compete in the following areas:

- Questions asked by host from fact sheet provided by contestant.
- Random question from bowl.
- Modeling of party dress for poise, grace and confidence.

Please prepare an introduction that includes your name, grade and school you attend. For example: “My name is Jane Doe and I am in the sixth grade at Perryville Middle School.”

Optional Talent Competition

We will be hosting an optional talent competition with the winner being showcased at Riverfest. This is an optional event. Talent is not required to win any of the titles of Riverfest.
